The Wisconsin Lions State Bowling Tournament is held annually on a rotating basis throughout the Districts of MD27. The tournament is open to all Lions and Leos in good standing. **Use of a non-Lion bowler will disqualify your scores.**

Applications must be completed in full with all the required information. **LCI Member Number is required.** To find your member number, check the label of your Lion magazine or see your club secretary or treasurer.

The annual Lions State Bowling Tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis. Each bowler shall receive a handicap of 90% of the difference between his/her average and 235 pins in each event entered. The handicap allowed shall be taken from the USBC handicap manual. Each bowler shall use his/her previous year's highest sanctioned average in any league in which 21 games or more were bowled. If he/she does not have a previous year's average, the bowler may use his/her highest current sanctioned average as of January 31, 2023, provided 21 games or more have been bowled.

If he/she has no sanctioned average and he/she has a Non-Sanctioned (NS) League average in which 21 games or more were bowled, please indicate that average. If he/she has no USBC/NS average but he/she bowled in State Lions Tournament with a minimum of 9 games, he/she will use the Lions tournament average. If no previous years or current average, men will be required to use 150 pins and women will be required to use 125 pins.

The team captain shall verify averages. Failure to use the proper average or make corrections in averages prior to completion of first games shall disqualify score(s) if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average, if it is higher (USBC rule 319a-3), the USBC rule 319a-2 and 319d apply with regard to reporting of tournament prize winning and 15-pin reference on submitted average. Bowlers must be familiar with re-rating requirements of USBC Rule 319c. USBC Rule 317 is at the discretion of the host club.

All prize money will be returned 100% in the event entered on a handicap basis. The champions in each event shall be declared by actual pin fall plus handicap and will receive appropriate recognition. Prize will be a minimum of 1:7.

Give name of each event. The word "reserved" or "partner" is unacceptable. Please enter the USBC average and number. If no USBC average, we will use a NS (non-sanctioned) average, lions average or first-time bowler and use a 150-pin average for men and 125-pin average for women.
